## **PLANT CARE-**Hydrangea



Flowering: Blooms in summer. Flowers can be pink, blue, purple,

white, depending on soil's pH

Light: Partial shade to full sun **Humidity:** Average humidity

**Temperature:** Hardy in most climates

Soil: Well-draining, acidic soil

Water: Regular watering, do not let the soil dry out completely

**Fertilizer:** Fertilize in spring and summer with a balanced fertilizer

Pests & Diseases: Susceptible to aphids, spider mites, and powdery mildew

**Propagation:** Can be propagated through stem cuttings or layer-

Plant Uses: Used as a decorative plant in gardens and landscapes, al-

so used in floral arrangements.
