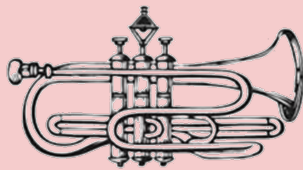

Quick Guide to Growing Zinnias

- Best Soil: Well-drained, rich in organic matter.
- Sunlight: Full sun (6+ hours)
- Watering: Water at the base, 1" per week.
- Care Tips: Deadhead spent blooms, space properly for airflow

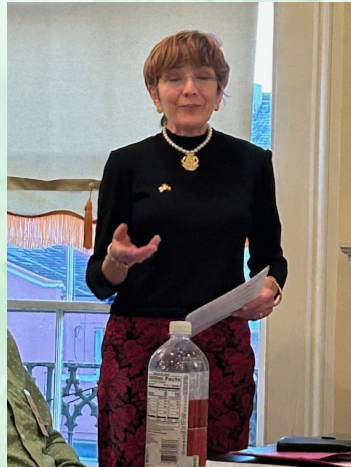
